FROM I.H. 35 coming from Austin-

Driving South on I.H. 35, take exit 225 (Onion Creek Parkway/F.M. 1626)

Once you have exited the Interstate, take your first major right (F.M. 1626)

Landmark: There will be a green sign pointing toward Manchaca.

Drive 6.5 miles, to the bottom of a hill, to a 4-way stop light.

Intersection: F.M. 1626 and R.R. 967

Landmark: Shell Gas Station

Turn left onto R.R. 967.

Drive 1 block to the Shamrock Gas Station (Sac-N-Pac)

Turn left, directly after the Shamrock, placing you on our street, Canyon Wren Drive

We are the third house on the right. Onion Creek Kennels is the second house on the right and has a big, redwood sign that says, "Onion Creek Kennels" in the front yard.

Our address is 902 Canyon Wren.

FROM Mopac or Loop 1, coming from Austin

Take Mopac (Loop 1) South until you get to Slaughter Lane. Turn Left on Slaughter Lane.

Landmark: Once on Slaughter Lane, Bowie High School is on your right hand side a few blocks up.

Then turn right at Brodie Lane.

Landmark: Diamond Shamrock on opposite right corner. CVS Pharmacy on left.

Follow Brodie through Shady Hollow subdivision until Brodie Lane. dead ends at a stoplight. Turn right on F.M. 1626.

Drive through one other stoplight, Bliss Spiller, until you come to the bottom of the hill at a 4-way stop light. Turn left onto R.R. 967.

CORGI HERDING INSTINCT TESTING

WHAT TO BRING:

- 1) A folding chair for yourself.
- 2) A flat buckle collar and regular leash as well as a place to put your dog (ie, crate) when he/she is not working. No flexi-leads, chain leashes, pronged collars, harnesses or martingale collars.
- 3) Poop bags to clean up after your dog
- 4) Layered clothing so you can add or take off according to the weather (remember—rain or shine!), also, sunscreen, a hat, and/or other sun protection. Please wear clothing that you don't mind getting dirty! You may also wish to bring towels for your dog after his romp with the sheep.
- 5) Sturdy shoes with some tread
- 6) Signed Release Form—you cannot participate without signing the release
- 7) Assigned run times will be announced after October 14, 2008 on http://www.overocorgis.com/6th%20annual_corgi_celebration.htm. We will start promptly at 8:00 am sharp. Please note: ALL dogs must check in on-site no later than 12noon on October 25th.

FOR THE SAFETY OF YOUR DOGS AND OTHERS, ALL DOGS MUST HAVE PROOF OF RABIES VACCINATION AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION IF REQUESTED.

INSTINCT TEST DESCRIPTION AND TEST ELEMENTS

The dog is brought into the arena on a long line approximately 6-15 feet in length. At some point while on the line, the dog should demonstrate a stop (down, sit or stand) and a recall before the line is dropped or removed. A dog, which cannot be recalled, shall not be left off line. Dogs must be immediately removed from the ring if physical force is necessary to protect stock from the dog.

RELEASE AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

The undersigned agrees to release and hold harmless Thomas and Jaime Bragg, Onion Creek Kennels, Onion Advent, Corgis & Critters, Inc, Karen Trimble, and all others associated with this Herding Instinct Test, in the event of accident, injury, or death to me or my dogs while participating in the events or on the property. I also agree to be held responsible for the wellbeing of the stock used while my dogs are in the pen. If my dog grips or runs down an animal causing injury requiring veterinary care, I agree to pay all fees associated with the incident. In the case of death to an animal caused by my dog while participating in the event, I shall agree to pay a replacement fee of \$200.00 per animal. Herding can be a contact sport—I understand I am participating at my own risk. I understand that the tester reserves the right to discipline or dismiss any dogs acting in a manner she deems dangerous or unnecessarily aggressive to the stock.
